



## **REGULATIONS FOR THE ADMISSION OF DOGS IN THE CAMPING**

In Camping Cala Pola with the purpose of ensuring a safe and pleasant experience for everyone, we have established the rules for the admission of dogs as follows.

Camping Cala Pola admits dogs exclusively in the Plots Plus Dog numbered from 1 to 31, both inclusive, and in the Bungalows Xaloc.

### **1. Admission and Registration**

- All dogs must be registered at the reception desk at check-in.
- It is obligatory to present a current vaccination card, passport and civil responsibility insurance.
- Dogs of breeds considered potentially dangerous (PPP) may be admitted under specific conditions detailed below.

### **2. Responsibility of the Owner**

- Dogs must be under control always, kept on a leash of a maximum of 2 meters.
- It is not allowed to leave dogs alone in plots, bungalows or vehicles.
- The owner of the dog is obliged to pick up the excrements generated by the dog and deposit them in closed bags in the garbage cans provided, both inside and outside our installations.
- The owner of the dog will be responsible for any damage it may cause to the rest of the campers and their property as well as to the camping installations.

### **3. Coexistence and Access to Common Areas**

- Dogs are not allowed in the toilet blocks, children's playgrounds, main bar and communal areas of the swimming pools. It is also forbidden in the supermarket and restaurants.
- Dogs are allowed to circulate freely on a leash. Dogs are welcome on the main terrace of the bar and on the terrace of the Xiringuito on the beach.
- Dog conduct must be appropriate, preventing continuous barking or aggressive actions.
- The municipal ordinances for the use and enjoyment of the beaches and the protection, control and possession of animals of Tossa de Mar prohibit bringing pets on the beaches of Tossa, both on the sand and in the water, between April 1 and October 31.

### **4. Requirements for Potentially Dangerous Dogs**

- Owners of dogs of breeds considered potentially dangerous must present:
  - 1.- Valid license for the possession of potentially dangerous dogs, as established by the applicable national or regional regulations.
  - 2.- Obligatory civil responsibility insurance covering damages to others, as established by Royal Decree 287/2002, of March 22; Law 50/1999, of December 23; Law 10/1999, of July 30, on the Legal Regime for the Possession of Potentially Dangerous Animals, as well as its complementary or applicable regional regulations.
- These dogs must always wear a muzzle and be kept on a non-extensible leash of a maximum of 2 meters.
- They may not access common areas and must be supervised at all times by a responsible adult.
- Breeds considered potentially dangerous: Pit Bull Terrier, American Staffordshire Terrier, Staffordshire Bull Terrier, Rottweiler, Dogo Argentino, Fila Brasileiro, Tosa Inu and Akita Inu.

## **5. Penalties and Exclusions**

- Any user, client or visitor will not be admitted to the camping or will be excluded from the camping site if his dog's conduct disturbs the peace and harmony of the other campers.
- The non-compliance with these rules may result in expulsion from the camping without the right to reimbursement.
- The camping reserves the right to refuse admission to dogs that may represent a risk to the safety of other guests.

## **6. Dog friendly area**

- Our lodging is Dog Friendly and for this reason we have services for your enjoyment.
- Special showers for dogs.
- Bag dispensers in the area of Parcels Plus Dog, Bungalows Xaloc and in the Pipican.
- A pipican where your dog can run, play, sniff and explore off-leash in a safe area, always under the supervision of its owner.
